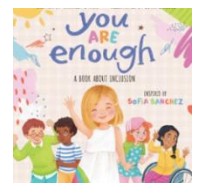

Prayer Focus: The Lord's Prayer

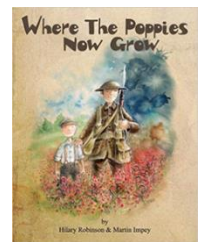
Bible Quote: John 15:13

Picture book: Is it because?

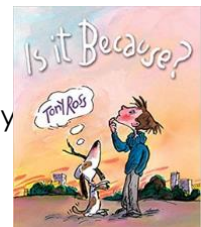
Key vocabulary: Bullying, five times on purpose,

To consider our own prejudice, and to challenge students to resolve to try to stop acting according to that prejudice.

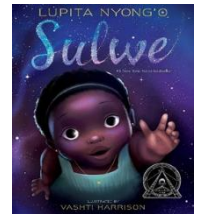
Picture book focus: Sulwe

Christian Value: Peace **Character Muscle:** Determination

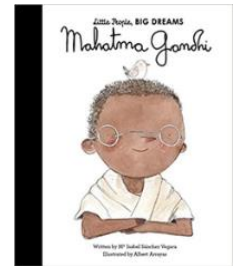
Prayer Focus: The Lord's Prayer

Picture book: We move together

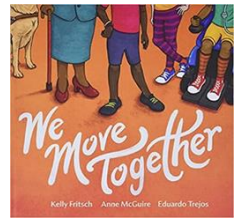
Key vocabulary: Disability, mental health, talents, kindness
